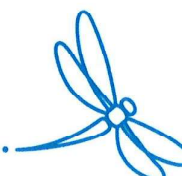

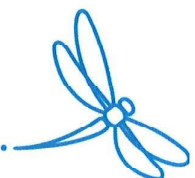
Corporate identity

Service delivery

- Undertake turf management duties through planning and upgrading of new and existing turf areas such as but not limited to:-
 - General maintenance work such as fertilising, weeding and turf replacement
 - Identification of pests and diseases and use of appropriate methods of control
 - Preparation and application of herbicide, pesticide and fertilisers
 - Turf renovation and refurbishment activities
 - Irrigation systems maintenance and repair, including controller programming and operation
 - Maintaining the cleanliness, safety, and presentation of turf areas across the Darwin Municipality
- Operate and maintain plant and equipment associated with turf operations including but not limited to tractors, implements, lawn mowers (including ride-ons), brushcutters and spray equipment.
- Autonomously operate tractors used for turf management and associated range of attachments
- Assist with administration tasks including but not limited to updating work schedules, record keeping, inspections, safety audit reports and similar, as required
- Assist with mentoring, coaching and developing the skills and knowledge of less experienced team members.
- Maintain current knowledge of irrigation control systems used by the City of Darwin
- Undertake pre-start inspections and reporting, and routine maintenance of all plant and equipment
- Ensure all turf management tasks are undertaken in accordance with daily / weekly / monthly or yearly schedules
- Utilise resources and fleet in accordance with the Code of Conduct and relevant procedures or policies



- Undertake duties relevant to City of Darwin operational requirements within the scope of this position such as small project work, cyclone clean-up and other ad hoc requirements as identified.
- Communicate and engage appropriately with community members when out on site in accordance with our Code of Conduct.

Team support (people and capability)

- Work professionally, cooperatively and respectfully with other team members to accomplish joint tasks and build positive working relationships.
- Be flexible and adaptable to working in various work locations throughout the municipality as needed to perform the role effectively.
- Undertake any other duties within the skill and scope of the position or your skill set, as directed.
- Actively participate and contribute to team meetings and other relevant forums, events or organisational meetings as required.
- Proactively engage in performance management processes (ie. probation reviews and annual performance appraisals) as required.

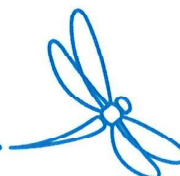

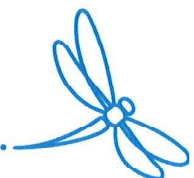
